The Institute also organises seminars, conferences, and workshops.

In view of the significance of the training, the Council of Islamic Research Institute in its 11<sup>th</sup> meeting held on October 27, 2017, approved the following three permanent training programmes of the Institute:

- (1) Undergraduate Training on Research and Technical Writing;
- (2)Postgraduate Training on Academic Research and Scientific Writing; and
- (3) IRI International Postdoctoral Fellowship

It is hoped that these training programmes will elevate the researchers to a position where they would better understand all dimensions of the Islamic thought, history, and culture. Equipped with such training, these researchers will be able to conduct and produce their own research independently. Furthermore, these training programmes will contribute to preparing a cadre of researchers for the promotion of quality research.

#### UNDERGRADUATE TRAINING ON RESEARCH AND TECHNICAL WRITING

#### INTRODUCTION

In the light of the *raison d'être* of the Islamic Research Institute, the Undergraduate Training on Research and Technical Writing is designed to impart basic training in research writing.

#### AIMS AND SCOPE

This programme will train students for technical writing at an early stage of their academic career. The aim of this training is to equip them with fundamental skills of research and technical writing. Moreover, they would be introduced to research tools, so that they could articulate their thought within certain theoretical frameworks. This training will enhance their capacity when they embark on serious research in their degree programmes.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

The applicant must have completed 12 years of education (F.A/F.Sc/A level or equivalent) with enrolement in any undergraduate programme at IIUI or any other university.

#### **DURATION**

The training programme is one-week long, in which the students will attend training workshops five hours per day. The training sessions will be held at Islamic Research Institute, International Islamic University, Faisal Masjid Campus, Islamabad.

#### **PEDAGOGICAL APPROACH**

The training format would be a combination of various pedagogical techniques such as lecturing, interactive sessions, group discussions, presentations and research practices on short projects.

Once ready for conducting foundational research, students will be asked to produce a piece of research and technical writing by applying the techniques and methodologies of research that they have learned during the training programme.

#### **MODULES**

The training will consist of the following modules:

- Day 1 Capacity Building & Personality Development
- Day 2: Practical Training on Creative and Scientific Writings
- **Day 3:** Hands-on Assignments and Essay Writing
- **Day 4:** Training on CV Writing & Job Applications
- **Day 5:** An Overview of Learning Opportunities in Abroad & International Scholarship

#### **CERTIFICATION**

On full participation and successful completion including submission of take-home assignments, participants will be awarded testimonial certificates in recognition of the completion of their training.

## POSTGRADUATE TRAINING ON ACADEMIC RESEARCH AND SCIENTIFIC WRITING

#### INTRODUCTION(Aims & Scope)

A three-level academic research and scientific writing training has been specifically designed for postgraduate researchers. The aims of this training programme is to prepare a cadre of researchers for the promotion of quality research. The main focus of the postgraduate training is to equip students with modern techniques of research writing and applied research methodology. This training will enhance the understanding of researchers in a broader perspective where they would be able to differentiate between academic writing and non-academic writing while conducting their own subjectbased research. Management and organisation of research are the key elements in taking up any research project. This training programme will significantly enhance researchers' abilities in these fields.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRIRERIA**

#### Level 1:

16 years of education (BS/LLB/MA/MSC) or equivalent with enrolment in MS/LLM/PhD programme of IIUI or any other university

#### Level 2:

Same qualification along with successful completion of the level one

#### Level 3:

Same qualification along with successful completion of the level two

#### **DURATION**

Postgraduate training programme will be completed in three levels. Each level will be of one-week workshop. During the gap between two training workshops, the trainees will be required to complete specific research tasks at home. The trainees would remain in contact with their respective faculty advisors at the Institute. The methods of distance learning will also be used for that purpose. The whole programme will be completed in one year.

#### PEDAGOGICAL APPROACH

At the beginning of the training, theoretical framework would be explained to the participants. In this part, they will be informed about various kinds of writing techniques.

In the second stage, interactive sessions of the participants will be arranged to make them brainstorm

ideas about their writing-skill aptitude and knowledge and to assess their research capacities.

The training will be divided into the following three levels:

Day 1: Research Discourse and Academic Writing

Day 2: Introduction to Writing Process

Day 3: Application of Paragraph Methodology in Writing Process

Day4:The Structure of Research Article and Research Essay

Day 5: Finalisation of Research

#### Level-3:

## Technical Editing and Production of Quality Research

Day 1: Introduction to the Art or Methodology of Editing Day 2: Manuals of Style

Day 3: Introduction to Research Journals

Day 4: Publication Process of the Research

Day 5: Presentation of Research Articles and Closing Ceremony

#### **CERTIFICATION**

The duration of the three levels of this programme is one academic year. Each level of the training is independent. Transfer to the next level is contingent upon satisfactory completion of research activity during the time period between the two levels. In case a trainee does not want to continue the next level, a certificate of the particular level that the trainee has completed will be issued. On completion of each level, a separate certificate and transcript will be issued. The candidates who will complete all three levels of the training shall receive a testimonial diploma in recognition of their completion of the programme.
